- The project would honour the deed of gift (ie for recreational / educational / non commercial)
- The redevelopment would be a Community Project from start to finish

The problem

- How to run a non commercial project and still be sustainable / self supporting financially ?
- Do we want to rely on the hiring out of costly communal event space for income? Should these not be free at least for community health recreation and educational purposes?
- How to implement Good Sustainable Energy & Communal Living Policies in the design & build
- How to engage the local and wider community in the vision
- How to come up with a strategy that is supported by the community to reach the vision and long term running of the building/project
- How will the project affect the community.
- How to engage the community into becoming involved with ownership of the project, from design and build to running of the project
- How to engage and encourage awareness / ownership in this and other Common Good Assets
- How does a community become involved in planning and creating a vision.
- How do we create a independent resource for pleasure leisure and learning that is useful to a variety of different groups and activities in the local and wider community.
- We do not wish to be beholden to groups who will negociate in their favour rules which will detract from the communal goal, any more than we need to, so how to use, adapt, share our own resources to help to develop the project
- Would tying in with other project with similar goals help?

This is not a public meeting. No one is being asked to commit to anything. We simply wish to discuss how to bring in wider community participation: (public meetings, networks, events, questionnaires, surveys etc)

Can we create a community toolkit and user manual that can help out in this process. All help and input welcome.
