Minutes Last meeting cancelled

 Funding – we seem to be having trouble in releasing funds – previous treasurer of LEGUP has left leaving sole signatore Carol Henry in charge – she was part of the original meetings which agreed to dissolve LEGUP & Fairfield Trust and start Common Good Glasgow, but still has not transferred remaining LEGUP funds which were agreed to be used for PI Dinner Nights, Garden Bills and Garden Needs.

A generator could be hired for the week and we are having a workday on Sunday - MB is already owed £24.41, and like many other community members is currently struggling to pay bills. The funding seriously needs to be sorted. Previously the LEGUP Treaurer had a policy of handing over a small slush fund in return for an account update plus receipts of how money has been spent. CH view is that this is not possible.
